

## ASGA Tampa Bay Chapter Golf Outings Guidelines

### General Guidelines:

- Place personal marks on your ball for easy identification
- Limit cell phone use to emergency calls only; turn off ringers while on the course
- Each group shall select a Captain
- The Captain will make rule decisions and is responsible for pace of play
- All players shall play "ready golf" from tee to green (Carry an extra ball and be ready to drop with minimal delay in play; prepare for next shot while waiting for others to take their shot; after finishing play, wait until off the course to pack equipment, etc.....)
- Limit search for lost ball to three minutes
- ◆ For out-of-bound (OB) shot, drop ball from point ball crossed out-of-bound (OB) and apply one stroke penalty
- ◆ Relief permitted if lie is in unsafe area for equipment/player (*deep divot, tree root(s), standing water, or muddy area*)
- ◆ Relief permitted when ball is against man made obstacles, permanent or temporary (*Drop one club length behind the lie*)
- ◆ Pick up ball after reaching maximum strokes per hole, based on golf format announced at each outing
- Record actual scores, not equitable strokes (ESC) on score card
- No mulligans are allowed

### On the Green:

- Carry a ball marker and mark your ball placement on the green
- Remain quiet and still while team mates are putting
- ◆ Putting out is optional when ball is within distance between putter head and where grip starts (aka "in the leather")
- Advance to next tee box before recording scores

- ◆ These items do not apply when playing in the Club Championship
